

## Defined Case Categories - Minimum Numbers Required (begins Sept 2012)

**Resident Roles: (only one resident per role / residents must be “scrubbed-in” to claim a case.)**

1. **Lead resident surgeon:** may include aspects of all below as well as participation in the critical portion of the case.
2. **Senior resident surgeon:** may include aspects of all below as well as participation in the surgical procedure between opening and closing.
3. **Assistant resident surgeon:** includes positioning, sterile preparation, monitoring devices, microscope preparation, participation in the initial (“opening”) or final (“closing”) portions of the case, and/or assisting the resident or staff surgeon(s).
